WIDENING PARTICIPATION

What is Widening Participation?

We know that results and predicted grades don't always show the full picture of an applicant's efforts and academic journey. If you have experienced particular events or challenges (such as those set out in the list to the right) which may have made it more difficult for you to meet our standard entry requirements, you could be eligible for an offer in line with our minimum entry requirements. This type of offer is often referred to as being "contextual."

Take a look at the list to the right to see if you may be eligible our minimum entry requirements and/or a contextual offer.

Am I a Widening Participation Student?

We consider you to be a Widening Participation/ Access Student if you:

- Are eligible and have taken part in the Lothian Equal Access Programme (LEAPS)
- Are care experienced
- Have caring responsibilities (unpaid for a friend or family member who due to illness, disability, a mental health problem or addiction cannot cope without your support)
- Are estranged from your family
- Are an armed forces/ex-military veteran
- Live in a target postcode which identifies you as living within one of the 20% most deprived areas in Scotland as defined by the [Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation](#).

Support for College Students:

Thinking about going to university or returning to education, especially after a long gap, can be daunting. Depending on your circumstances you may need to plan well in advance of actually starting your degree course.

We recognise that for all students, deciding to return to education is a big step and in order to plan for this change, you need to access information and advice. Head over to the Admissions booth to find out what route would be best for you and your career plans.
